Acts 2:1

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Acts 2:2

And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

And there appeared
unto them cloven
tongues like as of fire,
and it sat upon each
of them.

Acts 2:4

And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:41

Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

Acts 2:42

And they continued
steadfastly in the apostles'
doctrine and fellowship,
and in breaking of bread,
and in prayers.

Acts 2:43

And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.

Acts 2:44

And all that believed were
together, and had all
things common;

Acts 2:45

And sold their
possessions and goods,
and parted them to all
men, as every man had
need.

Acts 2:46

And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,

Acts 2:47

Praising God, and having
favour with all the
people. And the Lord
added to the church
daily such as should be
saved.

2. The Fire of Pentecost...

...brings the fear of God.

The Fear of God...

...brings manifestation.

...are you willing to tarry?

...to be a vessel God can
use?

The Fear of God...

...is a holy thing

...will not increase if the
personal life is not holy

...brings increase to those
who believe and live in it

The Cross...

...is relevant!

Acts 4:28

For to do whatsoever thy
hand and thy counsel
determined before to be
done.

Acts 4:29

And now, Lord, behold
their threatenings: and
grant unto thy servants,
that with all boldness
they may speak thy
word,

Acts 4:30

By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

Acts 4:31

And when they had prayed,
the place was shaken
where they were assembled
together; and they were all
filled with the Holy Ghost,
and they spake the word of
God with boldness.

Acts 4:32

And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

How hard...

...are we willing to fight?

3. The Fire of Pentecost...

...is being pressed in the
spirit.

Acts 18:5

And when Silas and Timotheus
were come from Macedonia,
Paul was pressed in the spirit,
and testified to the Jews that
Jesus was Christ.

Acts 17:16

Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry.

We need to be...

...so close to the Holy
Ghost to feel Him press
and stir us

Acts 16:6

Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia,

Do...

...what the Spirit of God is
telling you to do

(If the Holy Spirit says,
“No,” don’t go!)

Pray...

...like Jesus and get the
same results.

Acts 20:23

Save that the Holy
Ghost witnesseth in
every city, saying that
bonds and afflictions
abide me.

4. The Fire of Pentecost...

...releases special
miracles and apostolic
power.

Acts 4:33

And with great power
gave the apostles
witness of the
resurrection of the Lord
Jesus: and great grace
was upon them all.

Acts 14:3

Long time therefore abode
they speaking boldly in the
Lord, which gave testimony
unto the word of his grace,
and granted signs and
wonders to be done by their
hands.

Read in the epistles...

...the requirements for
apostles.

(The standards are very
high: they can't be
careless in speech.)

Acts 19:10

And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.

Acts 19:11

And God wrought special
miracles by the hands of
Paul:

So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.
