Therefore if any man be

creature: old things are
passed away; behold,
all things are become
new.

**And be renewed in the

And that ye put on the
new man, which after
God is created in
righteousness and true

Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.

Revelation 21:5

And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.

**Much more then, being now
justified by his blood, we
shall be saved from wrath
through him.**

Romans 5:10

For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

Romans 5:11

And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

1 Corinthians 15:51

Behold, I shew you a
mystery; We shall not all
sleep, but we shall all be
changed,

1 Corinthians 15:52

In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Isaiah 41:13

**For I the LORD thy God will
hold thy right hand, saying
unto thee, Fear not; I will
help thee.**

Isaiah 41:14

**Fear not, thou worm Jacob,
and ye men of Israel; I will
help thee, saith the LORD,
and thy redeemer, the Holy
One of Israel.**

Isaiah 41:15

Behold, I will make thee a
new sharp threshing
instrument having teeth:
thou shalt thresh the
mountains, and beat them
small, and shalt make the
hills as chaff.

Isaiah 41:16

Thou shalt fan them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them: and thou shalt rejoice in the LORD, and shalt glory in the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 41:17

When the poor and needy
seek water, and there is
none, and their tongue
faileth for thirst, I the LORD
will hear them, I the God of
Israel will not forsake them.

Isaiah 41:18

I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.

Isaiah 41:19

I will plant in the wilderness
the cedar, the shittah tree,
and the myrtle, and the oil
tree; I will set in the desert
the fir tree, and the pine,
and the box tree together:
