1. Know the Lord
is with you

Isaiah 41:10

Fear not, for I am with you;
Be not dismayed, for I am
your God. I will strengthen
you, Yes, I will help you, I
will uphold you with My
righteous right hand.'

Psalms 23:4

Yea, though I walk through
the valley of the shadow
of death, I will fear no evil;
For You are with me; Your
rod and Your staff, they
comfort me.

**2. Understand
you are loved**

1 John 4:18

Word about
your situation**

**His Word about your
situation must be on
your lips & in your

4. Trust God

Psalms 56:3

in You.

Isaiah 26:3

You.

**(You're failing
already if
you're not
trusting.)**

**There are things that will be
asked of you &
you will need to trust God to
help you,
stay in peace,
and if necessary,
do it afraid!**

**5. You must act
against your
fear**

Judges 6:27

So Gideon took ten men from among his servants and did as the LORD had said to him. But because he feared his father's household and the men of the city too much to do it by day, he did it by night.
