power.**

him according to his
excellent greatness.**

Psalm 150:3

**Praise him with the
sound of the trumpet:
praise him with the
psaltery and harp.**

Psalm 150:4

**Praise him with the
timbrel and dance:
praise him with stringed
instruments and organs.**

Psalm 150:5

**Praise him upon the
loud cymbals: praise
him upon the high
sounding cymbals.**

Psalm 150:6

**Let every thing that
hath breath praise
the LORD. Praise ye
the LORD.**

another in the fear
of God.**
