Developing the anointing

- 1. Stay full of the Spirit**
- 2. Pray in tongues constantly**
- 3. Receive the anointing from others who have it**
- 4. Anyone can receive and develop the anointing**
- 5. Look for the anointing**
- 6. Wait for the anointing, don't let time get you uneasy**
- 7. When the anointing hits, stick with it**
- 8. When the anointing is there, move in boldness**
