1 Samuel 16:11

And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.

anointing
just for you.**

**God is waiting for
you to step into
that which He
has anointed you
to do.**

God anointed

1 Samuel 16:13

Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

1 Samuel 16:14

But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.

**God's Spirit
leaves those
who dishonor
the anointing.**

**David honored
the anointing
before he was
anointed.**

**Saul
dishonored the
anointing, and
God's Spirit left
him.**

**Wait for and
honor the
anointing.**

**If you want to
know what God
is about to do,
get consecrated
& anointed.**

**The anointing is
the prophesy
about who he is
about to use, &
what God is about
to do.**

**And when he had so said,
he shewed unto them his
hands and his side. Then
were the disciples glad,

**Then said Jesus to them
again, Peace be unto

John 12:1

Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.

John 12:2

There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.

John 12:3

Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

John 12:4

**Then saith one of his
disciples, Judas Iscariot,
Simon's son, which
should betray him,**

John 12:5

Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?

John 12:6

This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.

John 12:7

**Then said Jesus, Let
her alone: against the
day of my burying
hath she kept this.**

**Mary was able to anoint
Jesus for His burial and
resurrection, because
she had just seen her
brother, Lazarus raised
from the dead.**

John 12:8

**For the poor always
ye have with you;
but me ye have not
always.**
