Luke 5:12

And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."

Luke 5:13

Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately the leprosy left him.

He is the same yesterday today and forever

You have to settle the question "Is God willing to heal you?"

1 Peter 5:8

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

Five enemies of healing

- 1. Blindness
- 2. Idolatry
- 3. Tolerance
- 4. Passivity
- 5. Unbelief

Blindness

We need to see the Lord's physical body that took the stripes for us

1 Corinthians 11:29

For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

1 Corinthians 11:30

For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep.

We need to see that Jesus atoned for all our sins

Isaiah 53:4

Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.

Isaiah 53:5

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

Whatever provision that was included in the atonement of Jesus is for each of us.

We have to see the spiritual body of Christ on Earth

2 Corinthians 2:10

Now whom you forgive anything, I also forgive. For if indeed I have forgiven anything, I have forgiven that one for your sakes in the presence of Christ,

2 Corinthians 2:11

lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

We have to choose to forgive those that do us wrong

We have to descern ourselves as part of the body of Christ

Romans 8:11

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

We have to discern ourselves as part of the body of Christ

We can't keep playing with offence, unforgiveness, and judgment

Idolatry

If you value and love and esteem something more than the Word of God

People are unconsciously placing higher value on some fact of life but God's Word is different

Isaiah 53:1

Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

You have to place the Word of God above everything else that you hear or possibly believe

Faith is about Who's report do you believe

We have to keep exalting the truth above the facts

You are not going to receive from God with your eyes on the calendar or the clock

Tolerance

Treat sickness like a friend instead of an enemy

John 10:10

"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

You are not going to get rid of it until you get mad at it

Passivity

Praying and asking God to come down and heal us

We need to look back at what He has done instead of asking him to do something else

We can't expect someone else to pray for us and get different results than when we pray ourselves.

Luke 9:1

Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.

Luke 9:2

He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Power - miraculous force and might Authority jurisdiction to function in the right of power

Unbelief

When you place all your faith hope and trust in an instantaneous healing

You can't quit give up or keep asking why it isn't happening to me

Mark 16:18

"they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

And when He came to the disciples, He saw a great multitude around them, and scribes disputing with them.

Immediately, when they saw Him, all the people were greatly amazed, and running to Him, greeted Him.

And He asked the scribes, "What are you discussing with them?"

Then one of the crowd answered and said, "Teacher, I brought You my son, who has a mute spirit.

"And wherever it seizes him, it throws him down; he foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth, and becomes rigid. So I spoke to Your disciples, that they should cast it out, but they could not."

He answered him and said, "O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him to Me."

Then they brought him to Him. And when he saw Him, immediately the spirit convulsed him, and he fell on the ground and wallowed, foaming at the mouth.

So He asked his father, "How long has this been happening to him?"
And he said, "From childhood.

"And often he has thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us."

Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!"

When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, "Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and enter him no more!"

Then the spirit cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him.

And he became as one dead, so that many said, "He is dead."

But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and he arose.

And when He had come into the house, His disciples asked Him privately, "Why could we not cast it out?"

So He said to them, "This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting."

Do not stop believing regardless of what happens

You can't let impatience move you out of faith

You can't let impatience move you out of faith
