These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

John 1:29

**The next day John seeth
Jesus coming unto him, and
saith, Behold the Lamb of
God, which taketh away the
sin of the world.**

Hebrews 10:1

For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

Hebrews 10:2

**For then would they not have
ceased to be offered? because
that the worshippers once
purged should have had no
more conscience of sins.**

Hebrews 10:3

**But in those sacrifices there
is a remembrance again
made of sins every year.**

Hebrews 10:4

**For it is not possible that
the blood of bulls and of
goats should take away sins.**

Hebrews 10:5

**Wherefore when he cometh
into the world, he saith,
Sacrifice and offering thou
wouldest not, but a body
hast thou prepared me:**

Hebrews 10:10

**By the which will we are
sanctified through the
offering of the body of
Jesus Christ once for all.**

Hebrews 10:11

**And every priest standeth
daily ministering and
offering oftentimes the
same sacrifices, which can
never take away sins:**

But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;

Hebrews 10:13

**From henceforth expecting
till his enemies be made his
footstool.**

Hebrews 10:14

**For by one offering he hath
perfected for ever them
that are sanctified.**

Hebrews 10:15

**Whereof the Holy Ghost
also is a witness to us: for
after that he had said
before,**

Hebrews 10:16

This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

Hebrews 10:17

**And their sins and iniquities
will I remember no more.**

Hebrews 9:14

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 9:15

And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

Isaiah 53:7

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

1 Peter 1:18

**Forasmuch as ye know that ye
were not redeemed with
corruptible things, as silver and
gold, from your vain
conversation received by
tradition from your fathers;**

1 Peter 1:19

**But with the precious blood of
Christ, as of a lamb without
blemish and without spot:**

John 19:1

**Then Pilate therefore took
Jesus, and scourged him.**

John 19:2

And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put it on his head, and they put on him a purple robe,

John 19:3

**And said, Hail, King of the Jews!
and they smote him with their
hands.**

John 19:4

Pilate therefore went forth again, and saith unto them, Behold, I bring him forth to you, that ye may know that I find no fault in him.

Luke 23:13

And Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests and the rulers and the people

Luke 23:14

Said unto them, Ye have brought this man unto me, as one that perverteth the people: and, behold, I, having examined him before you, have found no fault in this man touching those things whereof ye accuse him:

Luke 23:15

No, nor yet Herod: for I sent you to him; and, lo, nothing worthy of death is done unto him.

**Then the band and the captain
and officers of the Jews took

Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people.

**Now Annas had sent him
bound unto Caiaphas the high
priest.**

Matthew 27:3

Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,

Matthew 27:4

Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? see thou to that.

Luke 23:40

But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation?

Luke 23:41

And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this man hath done nothing amiss.

Luke 23:42

And he said unto Jesus, Lord,
remember me when thou
comest into thy kingdom.

Luke 23:43

**And Jesus said unto him, Verily
I say unto thee, Today shalt
thou be with me in paradise.**

Matthew 27:54

Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.
