what you
model**

**More things
are caught
than taught**

**Key to success is
child-likeness
with God and
being teachable
with man**

**Knowledge of
leadership
without the
Holy Spirit
relationship can
be disastrous**

**The reason there is
not a greater
move of God, is
due to a lack of
order in the
house of God.**

**Effective leaders
have a
relationship
with the Holy
Spirit.**

John 14:26

**"But the Helper, the Holy Spirit,
whom the Father will send in My
name, He will teach you all things,
and bring to your remembrance
all things that I said to you.**

John 14:27

**"Peace I leave with you, My
peace I give to you; not as the
world gives do I give to you. Let
not your heart be troubled,
neither let it be afraid.**

John 16:12

**"I still have many things to
say to you, but you cannot
bear them now.**

John 16:13

"However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

(and being
accountable to
Spirit-led people
helps, too.)**

**Pray, and ask the
Holy Spirit
what to do.**

substitute for

Acts 6:1

Then the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said, "It is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and serve tables."

Acts 6:3

**"but we will give ourselves
continually to prayer and to
the ministry of the word."**

Acts 6:5

And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch,

Acts 6:6

**whom they set before the
apostles; and when they had
prayed, they laid hands on
them.**

Acts 6:7

**Then the word of God spread,
and the number of the disciples
multiplied greatly in Jerusalem,
and a great many of the priests
were obedient to the faith.**

1 Corinthians 2:9

**But as it is written: "Eye has not
seen, nor ear heard, Nor have
entered into the heart of man The
things which God has prepared
for those who love Him."**

1 Corinthians 2:10

**But God has revealed them
to us through His Spirit. For
the Spirit searches all things,
yes, the deep things of God.**

1 Corinthians 2:11

**For what man knows the things
of a man except the spirit of
the man which is in him? Even
so no one knows the things of
God except the Spirit of God.**
